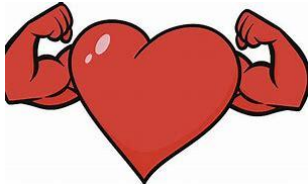

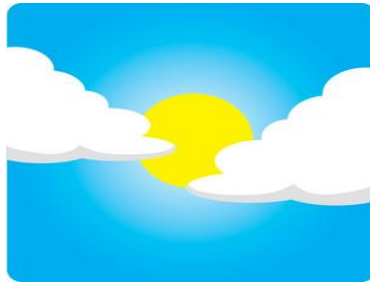
## **Benediction**
